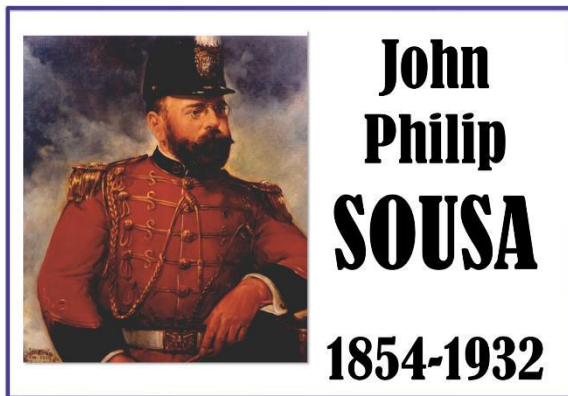
MOST IMPROVED AWARD:
